MEMORANDUM FOR: JAPANESE GOVERNMENT

SUBJECT:

Authorization to Pay Compensation

- 1. Reference is made to Central Liaison and Coordination Office memorandum, file C.L.C.O. No. 831 (1L), dated 26 March 1949, subject: Compensation for a Demobilized Person Who was Killed by an Electric Shock.
- 2. An investigation discloses the following information concerning the family of Mr. Masayoshi Uehara, deceased:
  - a. Address: 16-han, Mikabe-ku, Miwa-mura, Okinawa
- b. The names, ages, relationship to the deceased, and occupation are:

- c. Apparently the family is now living on relief and the individual members are unable to support themselves.
- 3. Permission is granted to pay compensation to the family of Mr. Uehara. It is suggested that a sum of \$60,000 would be appropriate. Any payment, under existing regulations, will be deposited in the Ryukyus Custody Account, National City Bank of New York, Tokyo Branch. Upon such deposit, appropriate authorities will be informed and subsequent payment in local currency will be made to the family of the deceased.
