Subject:

Protocols Amending Convention for Suppression of the Traffic in Women and Children, Convention for Suppression of Traffic in Women of Full Age, and Convention for Suppression of Circulation of

Obscene Publications.

Transmitted herewith for the information of the Japanese Government is a copy of a note dated August 10, 1949, from the Secretary General of the United Nations, stating that on July 25, 1949, the Government of Albania deposited its instrument of acceptance of: (1) the Protocol of November 12, 1947, amending the 1921, Convention for the Suppression of the Traffic in Women and Children and the 1933 Convention for the Suppression of the Traffic in Women of Full Age; and (2) the Protocol of November 12, 1947, amending the 1923 Convention for the Suppression of the Circulation of and Traffic in Obscene Publications.
